Fresh Start: A Home Where Women Can Grow

MORE THAN A BUILDING

Sam's life before Fresh Start did not give her much hope. She was in an unhealthy relationship. There were money struggles, and a lot of self doubt. These, along with increasing substance usage to cope, led to a great deal of instability in her life. She was arrested and given the option to come to Fresh Start as part of a pretrial program with Lancaster County Community Corrections. Sam did not know much about our program. She was in a hopeless place, without much support, and needed a change. She was skeptical that it would help, but willing to try.

"This place was the only thing that kept me going."

Now, Sam is in a different place, at least emotionally. While she still says Fresh Start keeps her going, she now has additional support from a recovery network and other positive relationships. She has been able to address health concerns, and will also soon celebrate 18 months of sobriety! She has a job and saved enough money for a car. She was sentenced to probation, in part due to how hard she has worked on her goals.

"I heard about people getting sober. I knew it could happen, but I didn't think I could ever do it. I didn't think it could happen for me."

Sam is getting ready to move into her own apartment soon. While she gives the credit to Fresh Start, we know it's her strength and perseverance that got her to this point. We provided the healing and hopeful environment, and she did the rest. This place is more than a building, more than a facility. It's a place where lives are changed.

SMOOTH SAILING?

Many of you have felt the jarring ride down the driveway, due to settling and a large pothole that was dubbed "Lake Havelock" after a hard rain. Volunteers patched it last year, but it was getting worse.

With winter coming and the pothole becoming a growing safety issue, it needed to be fixed. Well, no more "sailing" on that lake! In October, Fresh Start was excited to replace our driveway and parking area!

PLANTING ROOTS, TOGETHER



Like any home owner, there is always a long "honey do" list. Here at Fresh Start, the list of repairs and upgrades needed for our nearly 90-year-old building had been growing... and growing... and growing. The Board of Directors, with feedback from staff, decided to embark on a capital campaign. This was February 2020, and we all know what happened next! We did begin to raise funds for this campaign, and have been quietly doing so since late 2020. Now, we are going public with this effort

In addition to repairs to address wear-and-tear and safety of the large, spacious kitchen, the remodel will turn underutilized spaces into computer areas for filling out applications and researching resources. Additional spaces of respite will be created in the loft, and the outside courtyard will be refreshed for greater usability. Some of the upgrades won't be as noticeable, like a new fire system and better security cameras. The campaign also allowed us to retire our mortgage, and includes funds for future building expenses and program expansion.

We are at the point where we need your support. The pandemic and rising costs of materials and labor, along with identifying a few more projects, has resulted in an end goal to raise \$1.5 million. The good news is that we have already raised 85% of the budget, thanks to generous foundations, corporations, and individuals! We need you to cross the finish line.

"The positive environment inside the walls of Fresh Start has improved situations, reunited families and even saved lives," said Michael Reinmiller, Board President and member of the Capital Campaign Committee. "Gifts of all sizes will help make these spaces better suited for women in our community to continue to change their lives for the better."
